Agreement Defining and Limiting the Use and Handling of Christopher Wright's Buccal DNA Swab

This agreement, effective July 19, 2012, is made and entered into by the West Sacramento Police Department ("WSPD") and Officer Christopher Wright ("Officer Wright").

CONFIDENTIAL

Officer Wright agrees to provide a Buccal DNA Swab for the limited purpose of the extraction and comparison to the DNA profile(s) discovered on his duty firearm, currently in the possession of the West Sacramento Police Department, with the clear, undisputed and sole purpose of being used as a reference sample for exclusion and determination if criminal defendant Kevin Hughey's DNA profile was left on the firearm.

In consideration of Officer Wright voluntarily providing a Buccal DNA Swab, WSPD agrees and promises that WSPD will not, under any circumstance, enter Officer Wright's DNA profile into any DNA database or data bank including, but not limited to: the California DNA database and the Associated Data Bank Program, the National DNA Index System (NDIS), the Combined DNA Index System (CODIS), any DNA database or data bank in any of the 50 States of the United States, or any international DNA data bank or database including, without limitation, the United Kingdom National Data Base. WSPD further warrants and represents that the California Department of Justice ("DOJ") advised WSPD that Officer Wright's DNA profile will not be uploaded to CODIS.


Officer Wright's attorney or representative and a designated representative from the Yolo County District Attorney's Office and/or West Sacramento Police Department shall be entitled to be present when Officer Wright provides his DNA sample.

It is agreed that Officer Wright will provide his DNA sample in the form of a Buccal Swab. The two swabs will be collected in the following manner. A State of California- approved Buccal Swab kit will be provided to Officer Wright. Officer Wright will place the gloves from the kit on his hands and use the swabs from the kit to take two samples from his own mouth. Officer Wright will place the swabs in the kit and seal it. CSI Ruth Pagano will then take custody of the kit. Officer Wright's kit will then be delivered to the State of California Department of Justice (DOJ) for the extraction of the DNA sample and profile. Said profile will be compared to the DNA profiles located on Officer Wright's firearm.

After Officer Wright's DNA profile has been compared to the profiles located on Officer Wright's firearm, Officer Wright's DNA specimen and profile will be destroyed. If the DNA profile is necessary for the criminal prosecution of Kevin Hughey, it may be retained by the DOJ in a confidential file until the prosecution has concluded. At no time shall either the specimen or profile be entered into any searchable database or data bank. If the profile has been entered into any computer or program for purposes of comparison or during the profile extraction procedure, it will be expunged from said program or computer.

No other person than those necessary to complete the comparison of Officer Wright's DNA profile to the profiles located on his firearm shall be authorized or allowed to view or control such profile. The profile comparison results shall be released only to the District Attorney assigned, Officer Wright and his attorney.

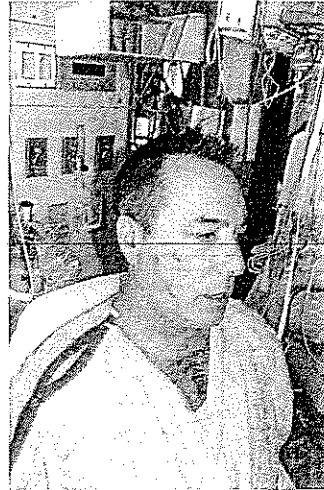

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- Several large scratches were observed on the right cheek of S-HUGHEY'S face. The scratches were vertical in position, red in color, and approximately .5 to 1 inch in length.

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- Two circular abrasions were observed on the right posterior arm, elbow area. The abrasions were approximately .5 inches wide.
- Numerous linear scratches were on both the right and left lateral sides of the back. The scratches were in both vertical and horizontal positions. The scratches were red in color and ranged in size from .5 to 5 inches long.
- A purple contusion (bruise) was also observed on the right lateral back. The bruise was irregularly shaped, somewhat vertical, and approximately 2.5 inches in length.

For reference purposes, a red pen was used as a scale- the pen did not touch S-HUGHEY'S skin, as to avoid infection.

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S-HUGHEY has several large colored tattoos on his abdomen, chest, and back. The tattoo on the abdomen, where the entry gunshot wound is located, is a dragon with flames. Due to the dark color of this tattoo, I could not view any bruising.

In addition to the images, I collected a BUCCAL swab sample from S-HUGHEY. I observed S-HUGHEY swab the interior of both of his cheeks and place the sample into the collection envelope. I wore proper protective equipment during the collection of DNA. The DNA sample will be submitted to the Department of Justice- Crime Lab for reference purposes.
